Paramedic Association of Canada (PAC) is comprised of over 20,000 paramedics from coast to coast to coast. The Association is a national organization of prehospital practitioners that exists to promote quality and professional patient care through working relationships among organizations with similar interests. Protection of the Public and development of the profession in the public interest is the foundation.

This mission will be accomplished by allowing the association to serve as a nexus for consensus building among all stakeholders. The purpose of PAC is to represent the practitioners on a national level. It accomplishes this goal through cooperative consensus building.

- Advancement of the profession & its representation & advocacy throughout Canada, across the full spectrum of policy areas & practices.
- Furthering the vision of recognizing paramedicine in primary health care, as a vital component of the publicly funded health system.
- Provision of comprehensive professional liability (“errors and omissions”) for highly competitive rates - \$54 per year through an agreement with *Marsh Canada*.
- Affinity* insurance programs and services (home and auto, health benefits, etc.); access to discounted group insurance - home, automobile, pet, travel, life, critical illness, etc.
- An informative website and weekly electronic newsletters dealing with Canadian developments.
  - The website includes links to provincial Chapters, paramedic partner agencies, employers, publications, and international affiliations
- Maintenance and redevelopment of the National Occupational Competency Profile NOCP—into the Canadian Paramedic Framework and many dozens of components.
- Collaboration with the Society for Prehospital Educators in Canada in the education of paramedics, and with the Paramedic Chiefs of Canada to further the profession.
- The Emergency Medical Services Research Agenda; Collaboration on national research initiatives to develop best practice guidelines.
- Support for the development and implementation of a national registration entry to practice examination.
- The Paramedic Association of Canada Benevolent Fund was established to provide financial support and access to scholarship funds for families of members of the national community of Paramedic Practitioners who have lost their lives in the line of duty.
